

Index to the Journal of the New Zealand Institute of Architects

The journal of the NZIA was published under several titles (including Proceedings of the New Zealand Institute of Architects, Journal of the New Zealand Institute of Architects) NZIA Journal, New Zealand Architect, Architecture New Zealand) over the years and was not indexed anywhere in its early years. (More recently it has been selectively indexed in Index New Zealand.) Three Architecture Librarians at Victoria University of Wellington compiled an index of all the articles published in it from 1912- 1990.

This index was published in 3 issues of the VUW School of Architecture's Working Paper Series covering 1912-1980 (WP 13), 1981-1985 (WP23) and 1986-1990 (WP 25).

Entries are arranged alphabetically by architect, building type/subject, place, author, and title.

xx is used in some places to indicate 'see', referring the reader to an alternative heading for information.

INTRODUCTION

In 1982 and 1986, cumulative indexes to the journal of the New Zealand Institute of Architects (under its many variations in name) were published as Working Paper WP82-13 and WP 23, respectively. This publication represents the next five year supplement, covering the years 1986 to 1990.

From November/December 1987 *New Zealand Architect* was incorporated into *Architecture New Zealand* and the numbering system changed. *New Zealand Architect* had issue numbers so that 1, 1987: 49-51 should read as the first issue of 1987, pages 49-51. *Architecture New Zealand* uses a range of months so that Sep/Oct 1988: 67-71 should read as the September/October issue, 1988, pages 67 to 71.

STRUCTURE OF THE INDEX

In general the structure follows that of earlier indexes - one alphabetical sequence of entries which may be accessed from some or all of the following points:

NOTES

Acronyms are filed before other words e.g BMW is filed before Bank. Numbers are filed as if they were spelled out e.g. 1985 is filed under N for Nineteen Eighty Five.

Book and film reviews are listed under the subject heading "Reviews". They are arranged by the surname of the author or, if there is no author, by the first word of the title. The Reviewers' names are not indexed.

Information is taken from the publication itself which may lead to minor variations in names, and partnership names have a tendency to change over the years so if you are looking for information on a specific building it is advisable to double check under the building type or location as well as the architect's name.
